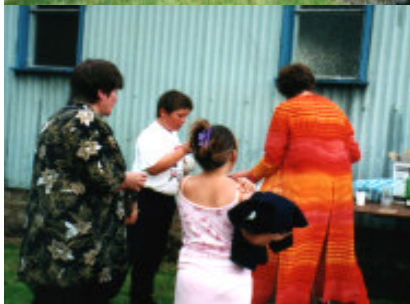


# THE VILLAGE MILLENNIUM PARTY
