The sock is then filled in a resin. Two piles will be driven beside the north west corner of the North Aisle. Obviously, this work can only be undertaken during summer months and not until we have raised £100,000.

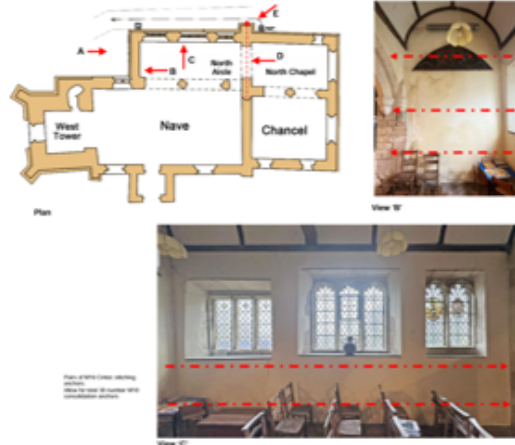
St Eustace North Aisle Stabilisation Project

Your help is needed!

Our Grade 2* church is in need of urgent repairs. Our North Aisle has several major cracks as it moves outwards and there is significant evidence of roof spread. We have consulted a number of specialists and been granted a faculty from the diocese to proceed. The North Aisle was constructed in the 1500's and the last major restoration project was 128 years ago!

THE PLAN

- stitching and stabilising of the two external walls of the church using Cintec stainless steel anchors (see right)
- Two piles driven in at the outside corner of the aisle to stabilise
- A discreet tie bar between the arch to support the spreading roof
- Making good, re-plastering etc
- The amount below accounts for our unusual geography, being up a hill with difficult access
- We hope to complete the work this year or early 2025

WHY WE ARE DOING THIS



St Eustace has been an important part of the landscape our local community for over 600 years and is a vital meeting place for worship, weddings, funerals and christenings. The church is always open for reflection and we have services twice a month. We know that many of you value the building, even if you're not regular church goers.

The Ibberton PCC have a duty of care to ensure the building is secure (and still standing!) for future generations to enjoy.

We have tried to keep this leaflet brief, but if you would like more information, please get in touch!

NB: Any donations left after the Stabilization Project is complete will be used to fund other urgent projects in the Church, these include repairing the lead on the Church Tower, saving a window in the North-West of the Nave and repairing the monument in the chancel.
