

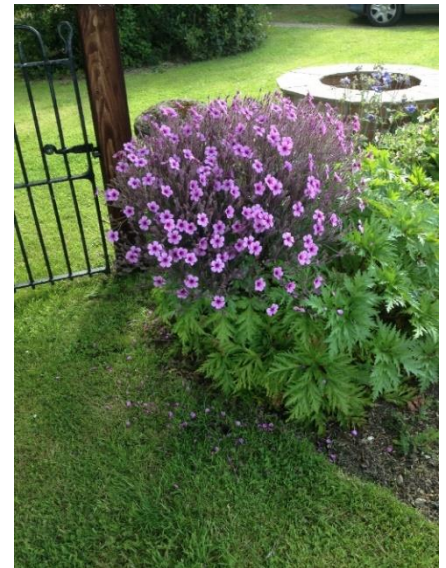
### OPEN GARDEN IN AID OF JULIA'S HOUSE
