Future works include repairs to the stained-glass windows, a monument within the church and the pruning of the yew trees within the churchyard. Perhaps a composting toilet will be installed – this will make the church viable to use for longer periods of time.

On Sunday 21st September at 3 pm a special service for St Eustace (St Eustace day is 20th September only 2 other churches in the UK are named after this saint) led by The Rt Revd Stephen Lake the 79th Bishop of Salisbury. This will be followed by tea in the Village Hall. All will be very welcome to join us.

If you would like to get involved either by taking part or sponsoring anyone more details will follow later. St Eustace Church has been very fortunate to have recently received two grants.

has been designed to be sympathetic to wildlife and offers a diverse mixture of ponds, a boggy area, a lush wildflower meadow, fruit bushes, trees, a productive kitchen garden, two greenhouses packed with chilli plants and much more. It attracts a host of insects busily exploring the rich variety of tree barks and plant species while a throng of busy, chattering birds weave through the bushes and scrabble in the undergrowth. The secluded garden is a tranquil, fascinating space set against the backdrop of rolling Bulbarrow Hill and makes for a very enjoyable visit. The well-attended event raised £540 for the National Garden Scheme.

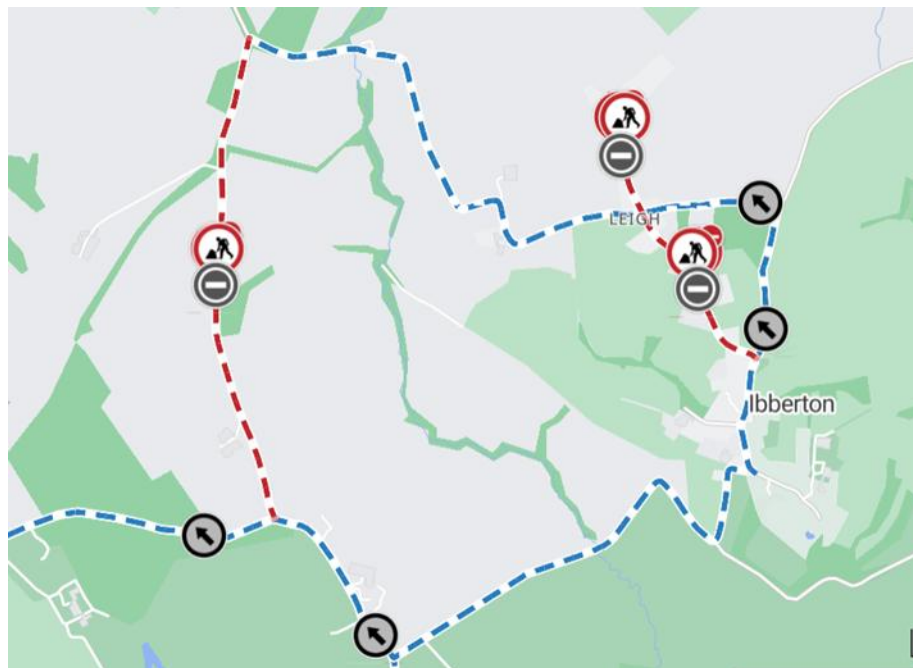
